



Wisconsin Regional Art Program 2010

The Greendale Public Library will host a Wisconsin Regional Art Program (WRAP) un-juried exhibit at the Library from August 2, to September 11, 2010. Non-professional artists 16 years old and older may submit works for the exhibition.

Each artist may enter a total of *three* works in any media or mixed media:

- **Painting:** Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor
- **Graphics;** Drawing, prints, Pastel, Collage
- **Sculpture:** Any Material, Mixed-Media
- **Crafts:** Clay, Wood, Metal, Fiber, Paper, Other
- **Photography:** B&W, Color, or Digital Prints

Not sure if your art fits these categories? Contact the Library.

Entry Guidelines:

- Program is open to non-professional artists and crafts persons.
- Artists 16 years old and older may submit works for the exhibition.
- All work must be ORIGINAL in concept and design. It must have been done by the person signing it. Copies of other artworks, copyrighted photographs or patterns cannot be accepted. No decorated kits are acceptable.
- Paintings made as copies during a teacher's demonstration are NOT eligible.
- Artwork must have been completed within the last *two* years.
- Art works must be suitable for viewing by all ages in a public space.

Artist Chad Lindemann, art instructor at Wisconsin Lutheran College, will serve as judge for the exhibition. Mr. Lindemann will be selecting a number of pieces as State Exhibit Award winners and the pieces will then be able to compete for prizes at the 2011 WRAP Annual State Art Exhibition and conference in Madison in September 2011.

Mr. Lindemann will also be doing a lecture and demonstration at the Library on September 11. Samples of his work can be found on his website www.etchedprints.com.

Entry blanks are due at the Library by Saturday, July 24, 2010. Entry blanks can be obtained at the Library or at www.dcs.wisc.edu/LSA/art/wrap/wrapentry.htm. Artwork is due at the Library between Monday, July 26 and Saturday, July 31, 2010. Entry fee to exhibit artwork and attend Chad Lindemann's workshop is \$20. The public is invited to attend this workshop for a fee of \$5. Checks may be made out to the Greendale Public Library foundation, Inc.
